- Your spreadsheet has 1,000 rows or less.
- Your spreadsheet is on Sheet1.
- Your spreadsheet doesn't contain any formulas, charts or blank rows.
- Your spreadsheet doesn't contain any errors (like #REF!, #NAME?, #N/A or #VALUE!).
- Names don't contain colons (:) or quotation marks (").
