

## Find the Download command on a Web site

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How you [download transactions](#) is controlled by the financial institution's Web site.

1. In general, look for a button like this:



2. If you don't see the button, sign in to the Web site.
3. On the Web site, do one of the following:
  - a. Go to the section of the Web site for downloading electronic statements by clicking a button, choosing an option from a menu, or clicking a link called something like **Download statements**, **Download transactions**, or **Export to software**.
  - b. Choose the account you want a statement for, and QuickBooks as the software to download to.
  - c. Click a button or link called something like **Download**, **Export**, or **Send** to have the Web site send the statement.

or

- a. Go to the account you want an electronic statement for.
- b. Request a statement for the account by clicking a button, choosing an option from a menu, or clicking a link called something like **Download statements**, **Download transactions**, or **Export to software**.
- c. Choose QuickBooks as the software to download to.
- d. Click a button or link called something like **Download**, **Export**, or **Send** to have the Web site send the statement.
