#### **NOTES TO THE CONDUCTOR**

The Magic of Harry Potter contains themes from all eight motion pictures from the Harry Potter series. The themes included are:

Gong/Triangle)

"Hedwig's Theme" and "Nimbus 2000" (from Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone)

"Fawkes the Phoenix" (from Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets)

"Double Trouble" (from Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban)

"Hogwarts' Hymn" (from Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire)

"Dumbledore's Army" (from Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix)

"Harry and Hermione" (from *Harry Potter and the Half-Blood Prince*)

"Ministry of Magic" (from Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows, Part 1)

"Showdown" (from Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows, Part 2)

"Leaving Hogwarts" (appeared at the end of both the first and last movies)

Please note that all metronome markings are just suggested tempi—feel free to adjust the tempo as needed. Specifically, "Fawkes the Phoenix" may be taken faster than marked, and conducted in "1" if desired.

All solos are optional as well, as each may be played by any number of musicians. "Hedwig's Theme" is scored for both flute and bells; however, you may wish to use only the bells. The marimba part in "Harry and Hermione" may be played on a xylophone using soft mallets.

The tom-tom part in "Ministry of Magic" should be played by only one percussionist. However, if you have extra players, adding additional tom-toms of various sizes from measures 153 through 172 will increase the intensity of the music. The crescendo in measures 168 through 172 should be as dramatic as possible without sacrificing a good sound quality.

I hope you and your ensemble find *The Magic of Harry Potter* to be an exciting and worthwhile musical experience!
